



EGYPT MATTA FAIR SPECIAL

4 Nights Cairo – Alexandria

Validity: Travel until 30th April 2027

Itinerary:

Day 1: Arrival Cairo (D)

Upon arrival Cairo International Airport, Exodus Travel representative welcomes and assists you through the immigration process. Then transfer to a local restaurant for dinner. Then transfer to hotel for Check in and have rest.

Overnight at the hotel in Cairo

Day 2: Cairo City Tour (B, L, D)

After breakfast at hotel transfer to visit one of the Seven Wonders the great Pyramids of Giza; (Cheops, Chephren and Mycerinus). The Cheops Pyramid is more interesting, because its interior burial chambers are open for inspection by the public. Not far from the Pyramids is the Great Sphinx of Giza, which dates from the time of Chephren, this unforgettable statue combines the head of a Pharaoh with a lion's body. Then enjoy a camel ride at the Pyramids. Your tour can't be finish without a quick visit to perfume Factory, cotton, and papyrus institute, to see how it is manufactured. Then transfer to a local restaurant for lunch.

After lunch, continue tour to visit the Civilization Museum; The first veritable museum of civilization in Egypt, it is located on the archaeological site of El-Fustat in Old Cairo, overlooking the Ain El-Seera Lake. The permanent collection is divided into two separate regions, one chronological and the other thematic, also, the gallery of royal mummies. After finishing the tour, transfer to the Nile Dinner Cruise for dinner.

Overnight at the hotel in Cairo

Day 3: Alexandria Full Day Tour (B, L, D)

After breakfast at hotel, to Transfer to Alexandria via the desert road –about 225 km– whereby you will start a guided tour to visit the Bombay's' pillars, the Catacombs and Roman Amphitheatre. Passing by Alexandrina Bibliotheca & overview Qait Bay citadel from outside. then transfer to a local restaurant for lunch.

Pompeii Column and Kom el-Shuqafa Catacombs Thirty meters high and built from Aswan pink granite, the Pompeii Column is thought to have been a present from the people of Alexandria to Emperor Diocletian. The majority of the remains found around the column can be seen at the Greco-Roman Museum. At the top of the hill lies the entrance to the Kom al-Shuqafa Catacombs dating from the first and second centuries. Drive back to Cairo then transfer to a local restaurant for dinner. Then transfer to your hotel for rest.

Overnight in Cairo

Day 4: Cairo Exploration (B, L, D)

Breakfast at the hotel, then visit Old Cairo: The Hanging Church is considered the oldest church in the area of Al-Fustat (Old Cairo). It is known as Al-Muallaka (the hanging) because it was built on the ruins of two old towers that remained from an old fortress called the Fortress of Babylon. And then visit Church of St. Sergio (Sergius), Abu Serga was built in the center of the Ancient Roman fort of Babylon. The church is considered as one of the sites visited by the Holly Family during their escape from Herod to the land of Egypt. Then transfer to a local restaurant for Lunch.



Then visit the Citadel & Mohamed Ali Mosque. You will be escorted to a fascinating maze of little streets, filled with numerous old monuments and mosques from Cairo's Islamic past. Saladin's Citadel, the impressive 19th century Mosque of Mohammed Ali, and considered the oldest university in the world. After finishing the tour, transfer to a local restaurant for dinner. And Overnight at the hotel in Cairo

Overnight in Cairo.

Day 5: Departure Cairo (B)

Breakfast at hotel and check out. Then transfer to Cairo airport for final departure.
